Make no mistake, when true disrespect is directed toward a specific parent or sibling and it's rude, it has to be dealt with immediately. If your child doesn't see where that line between disrespect and mild rebelliousness is, sit down with them when things are going well and say, "Listen, if you want to stomp up the stairs because you're disappointed and you think things aren't fair, that's okay with me. But if you start calling people names and being rude to family members, you're going to be held accountable for that behavior. So, don't go too far."

If you've noticed that your child has already crossed the line and is behaving in an increasingly disrespectful manner, you can say, "Look, there's a line that I think you're crossing when you talk to us". If you want to roll your eyes and say, "Whatever, that's fine with me. I don't want to fight with you about that. But name calling, and shouting are not acceptable. You are responsible not to do those things." Always put these ideas together for your kids: responsibility, accountability, and consequences. What that looks like is, "You're responsible to behave a certain way. I'm going to hold you accountable for that behavior, and there will be consequences if you don't take responsibility for it." 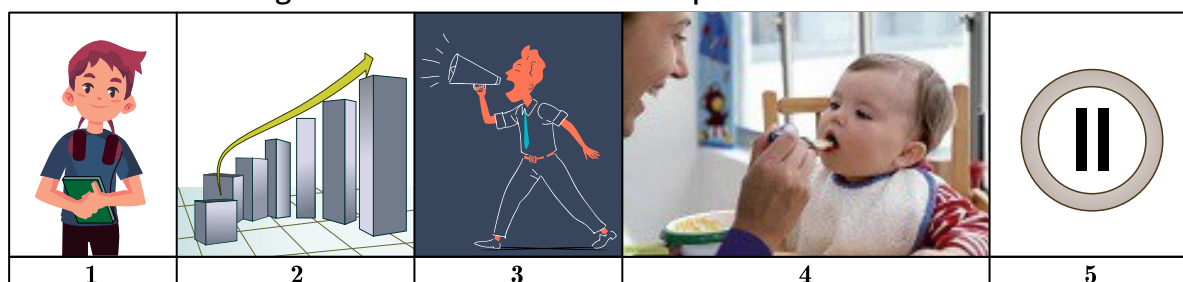

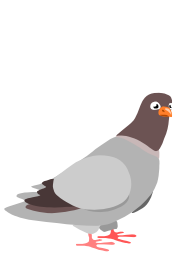

For English teachers, a dictionary is essential for any teaching program and needs to be used carefully. A dictionary is the basic thing for any language class. The most important thing that a student should know is how to use it. A student needs to have at least three dictionaries available to learn English properly. The first one should be bilingual dictionary that covers words in the native language as well as in English. The second one should be a monolingual dictionary that gives word information in English. The third one should be a native language dictionary.

When teaching begins, learners will use bilingual dictionary for simple translations.

Monolingual dictionaries are also necessary pieces of language learning studies, because they provide learners with definitions, pronunciations, etc. The problem becomes hard with studies when the students do not fully understand the words they are translating, and they get confused. Teachers know that they should clear up the confusion quickly before they jump into to the next lesson. When the students enter a more advanced level, they must have a native language dictionary that relates to their own language. When they do not understand the meaning of a translated word in their own native language, they can use this dictionary to figure it out.

According to David Crystal, there are about 400 million people who speak English as their first language around the world. Two out of three of those people are speakers of American English. Apart from countries like Britain, Canada, Australia, and the United States, there are about 70 countries, including Nigeria, Singapore, and India, where English is an official language, but not the first language. There are nearly 500 million people in those countries who can speak English. There are also people who speak English as a foreign language. These are people who learn English at school or in language academies. The British Council has estimated that there are about 1 billion people learning English. Of those, approximately 600 million have a good enough level to communicate. That means the total number of people who speak English is about 1.5 billion, more than 25 percent of the world's population. Curiously, in the year 1600, only 4 million people spoke English and the future of the language was in doubt. While English has grown, other languages haven't been so lucky. There are between 6000 and 7000 languages in the world today. Two and a half thousands of those languages are endangered. David Crystal estimates that "every two weeks, a language dies". He said young people need to be made more aware of the situation so that they can help save those languages.

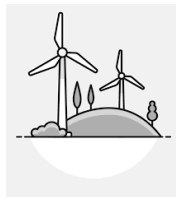

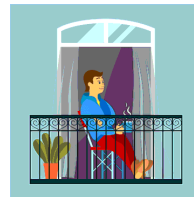
